New business

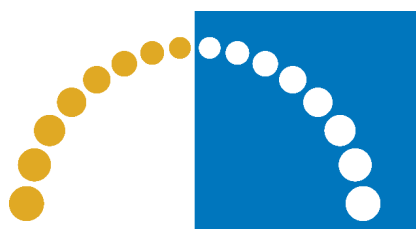
- New proposed president for APSWA – Dr Hezel Cohen.
